## POSITION VACANCY FOR TRANSPORTATION DIRECTOR

The Guilderland Central School District is seeking an experienced and progressive Transportation Director to serve the needs of approximately 5500 students. The suburban school district is located near Albany, New York. Transportation services are provided to students in the district's five elementary schools, middle school and high school. In addition, students attending private school and students with disabilities receive transportation services to another 65 schools in the area. The successful candidate will be responsible for leading a department of over 100 staff consisting of supervisors, drivers, mechanics, bus attendants, dispatchers, 19A driver/trainer and clerical staff with an operating budget of \$5 million. The fleet size is 114 buses. The district encompasses 50 square miles and operates on a three tier run structure. A new bus garage and transportation facility was constructed in 2003 and includes an automatic wash bay. The district is seeking an individual with at least five years demonstrated experience in transportation with at least one year in a supervisory capacity. Salary range is \$75,000 - \$90,000 depending on qualifications and experience. Anticipated start date is February 15, 2012.

This is an Albany County Civil Service title and the applicant must meet minimum qualifications to take the Albany County Civil Service test for the title of Transportation Director.
